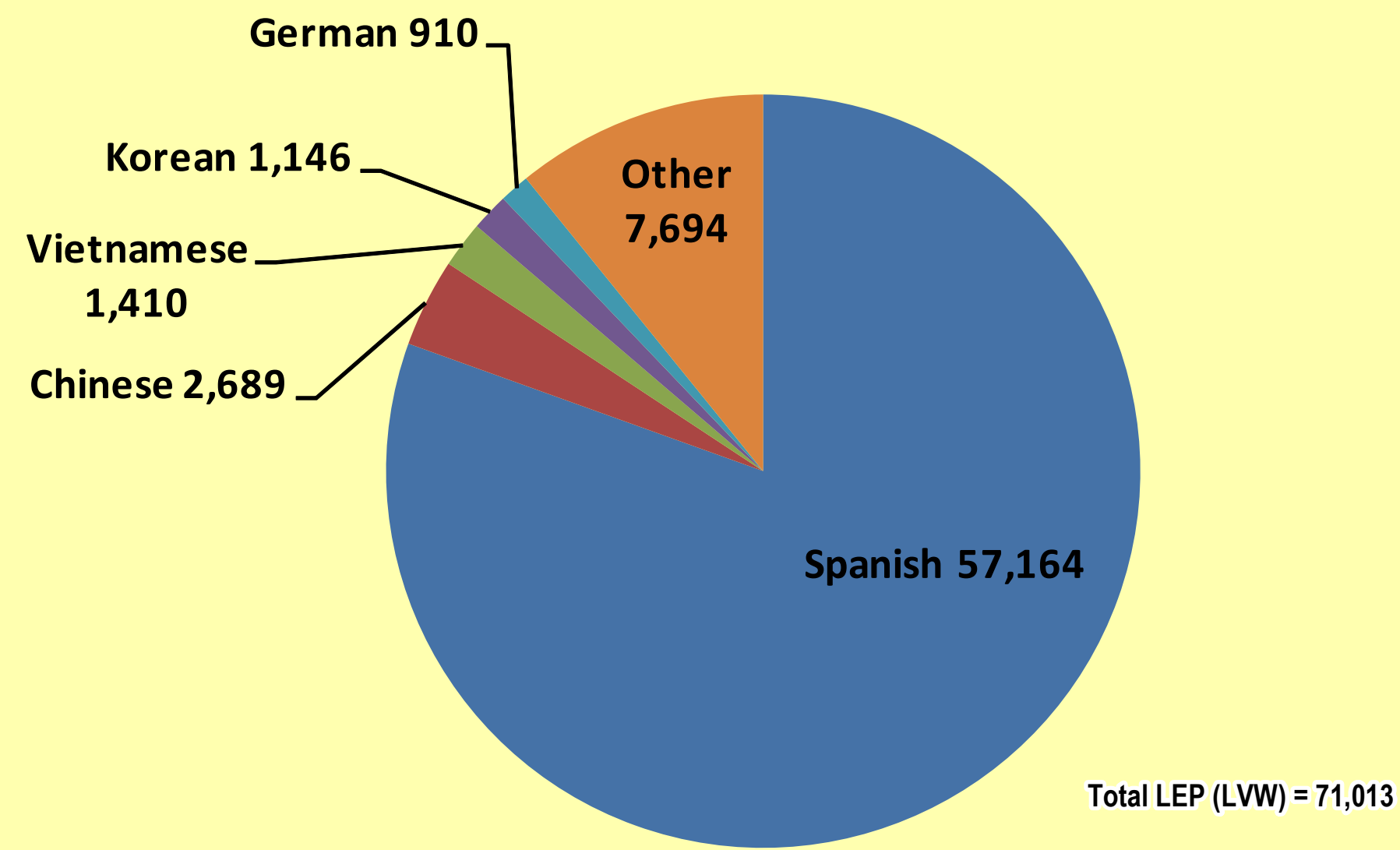


U.S. Judicial Districts - State of Alabama (2012)
Total Persons 5 Years and Over Who Speak a Language Other Than English at Home and Speak English Less than "Very Well"

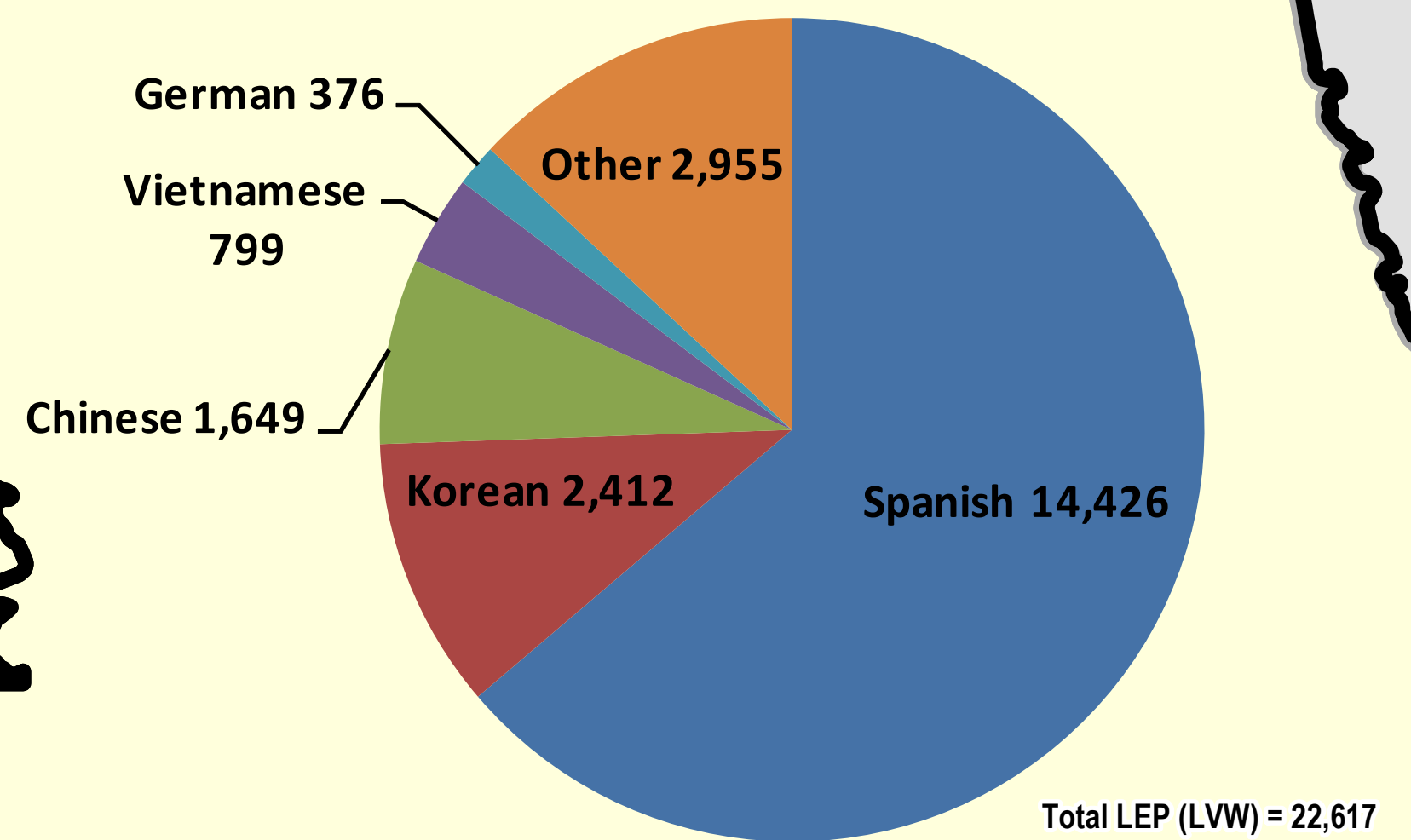

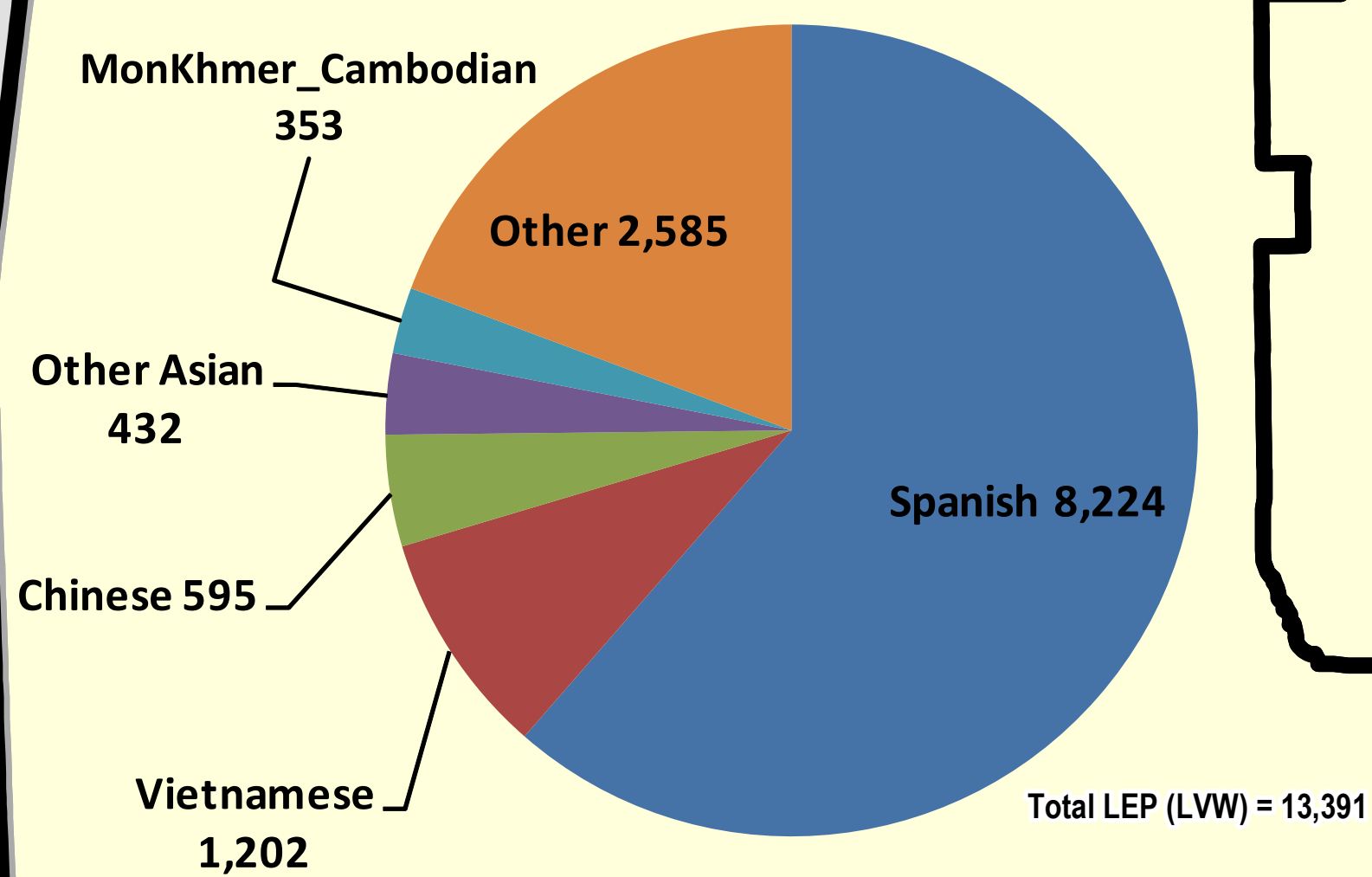

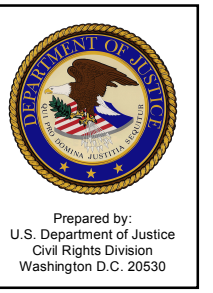
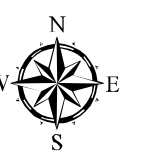
