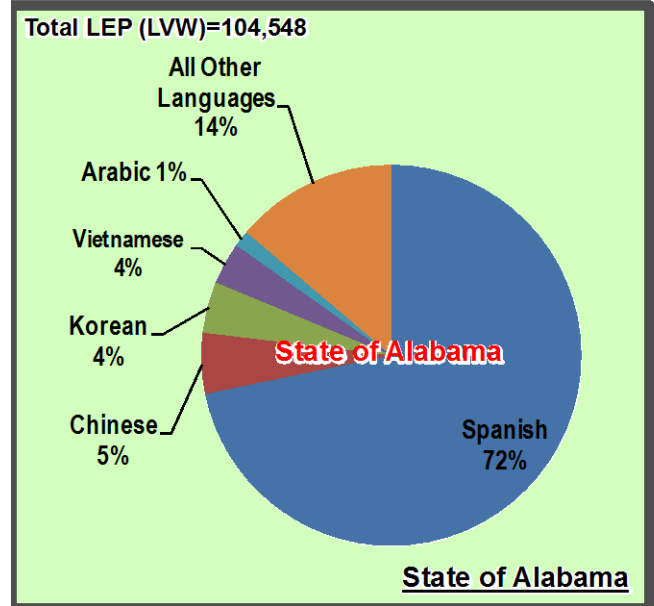
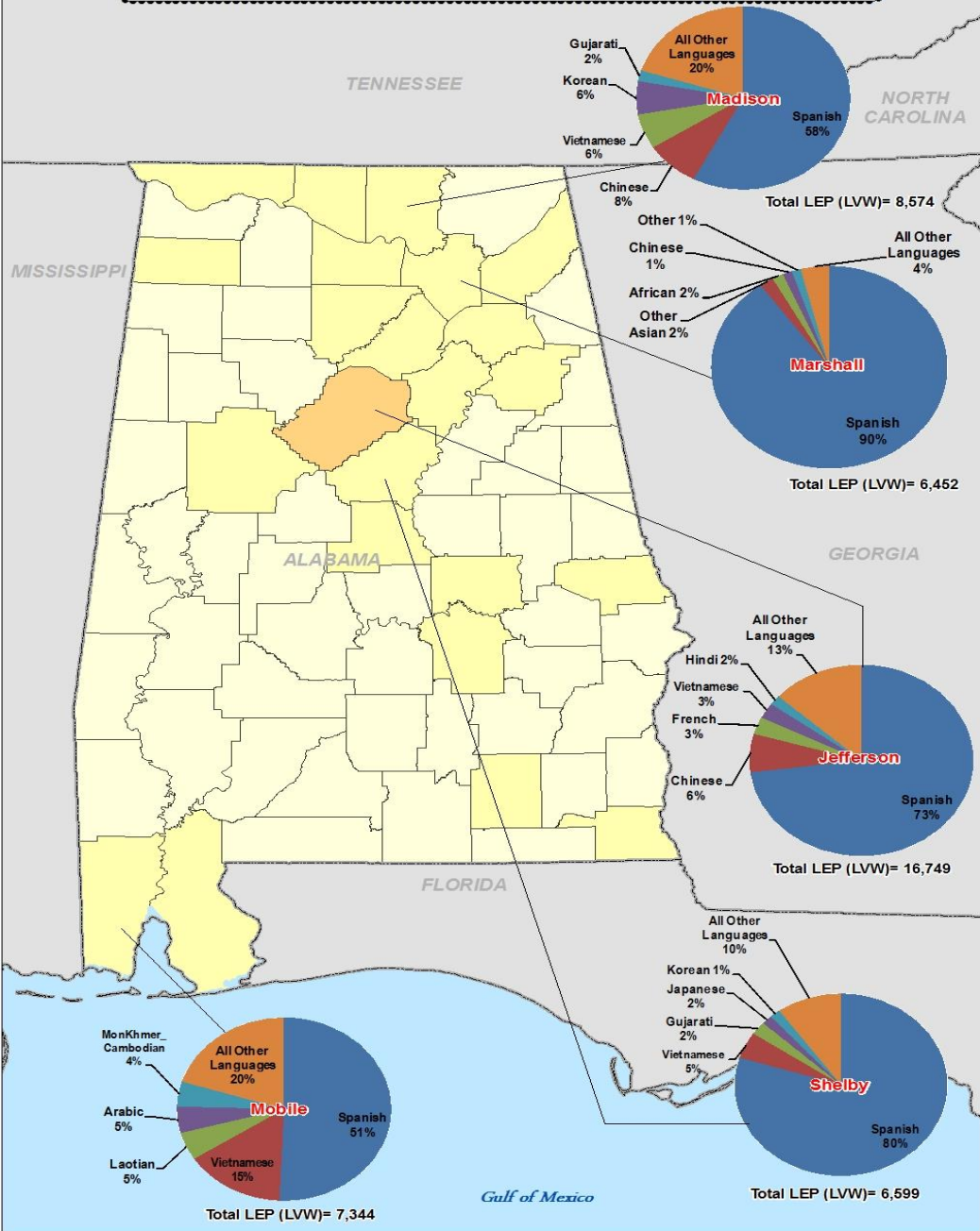

**Total Persons 5 Years and Over Who Speak a Language Other Than English at Home and Speak English Less than "Very Well"**



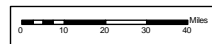
