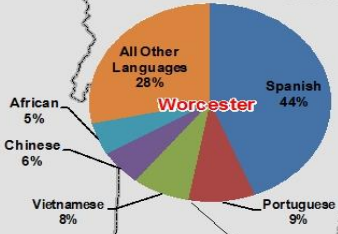


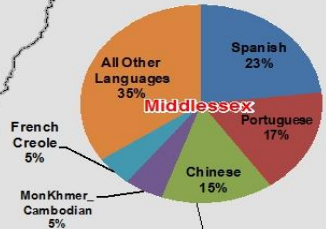


**State of Massachusetts (ACS 2014)

Total LEP LVW = 55,781

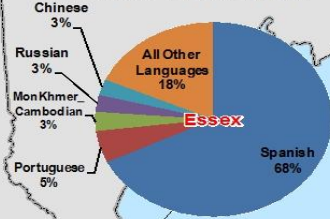

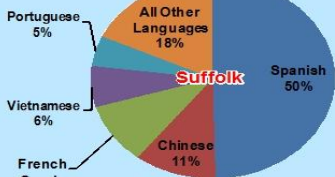

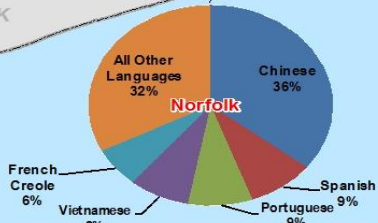

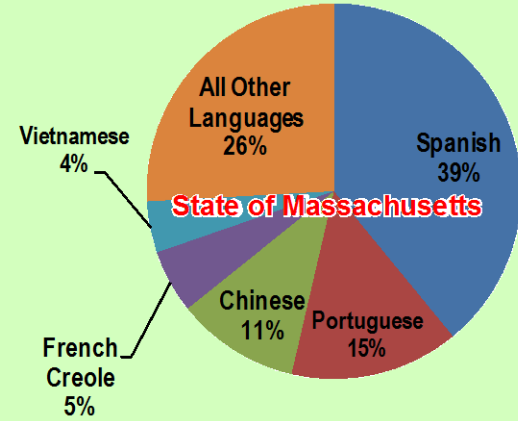
