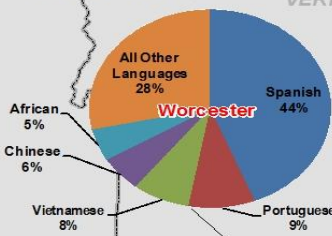


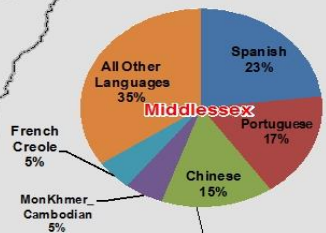

Other Than English at Home and Speak English Less than "Very Well"**

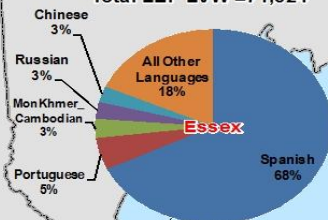

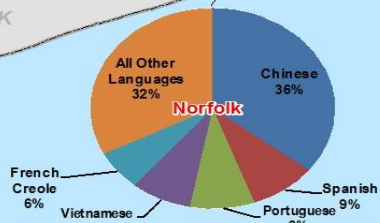

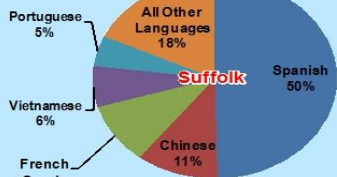

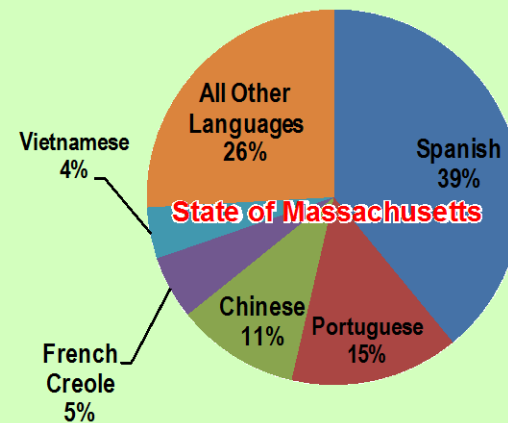

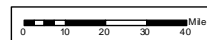
