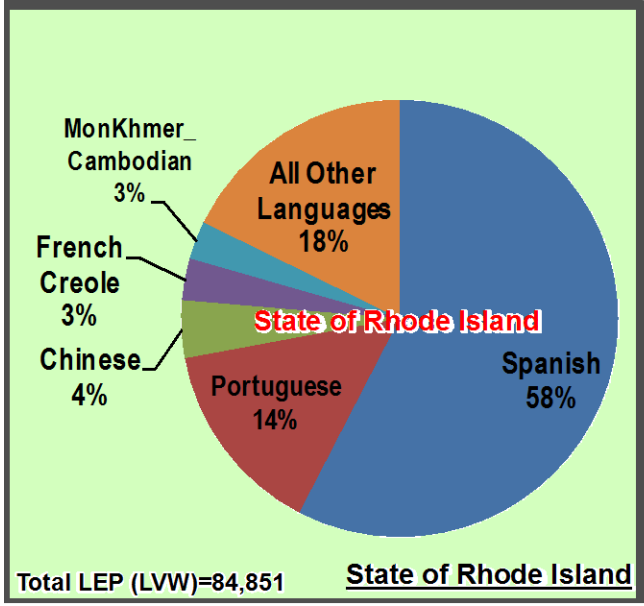
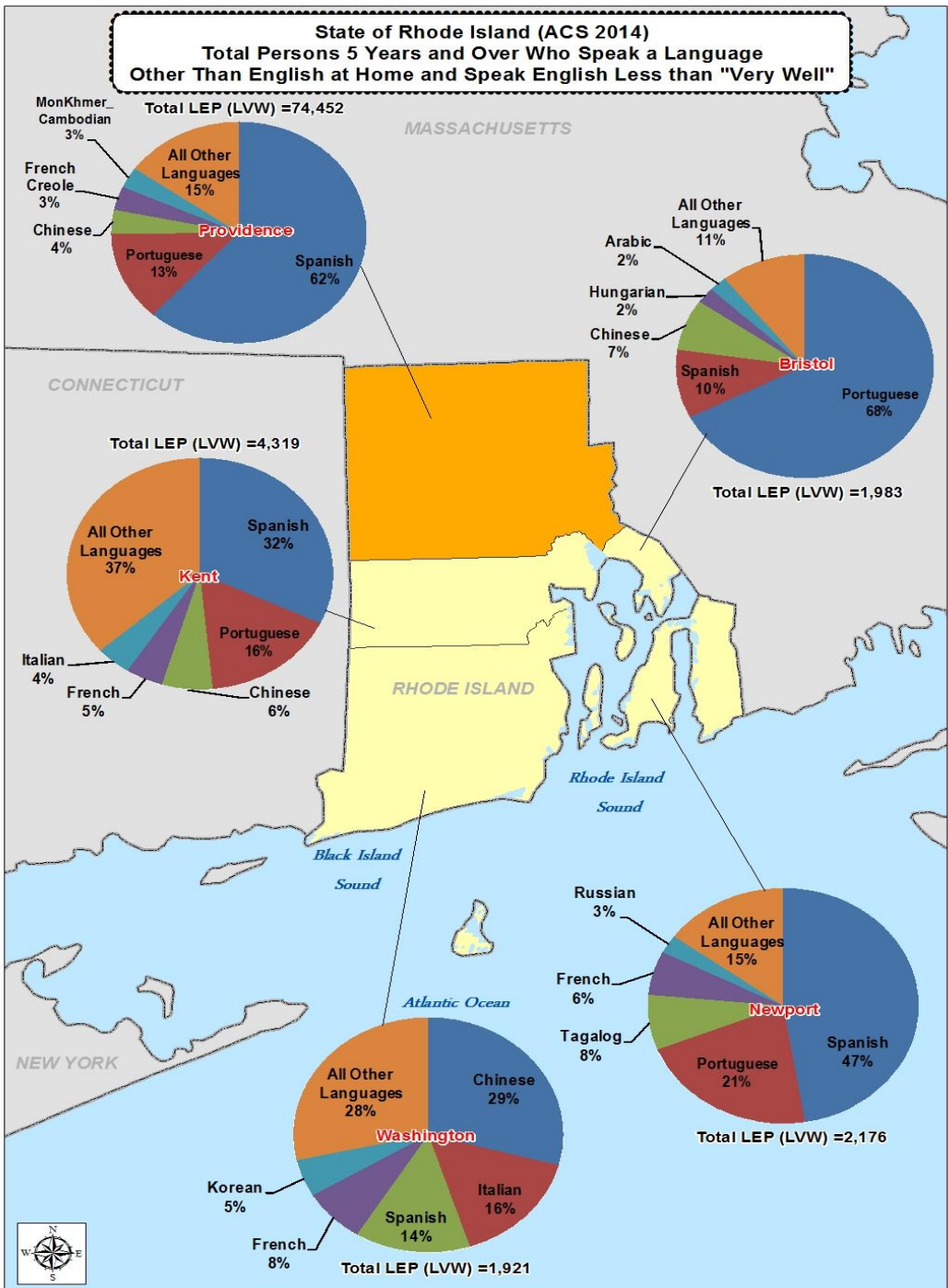


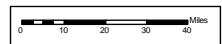
State of Rhode Island (ACS 2014)
