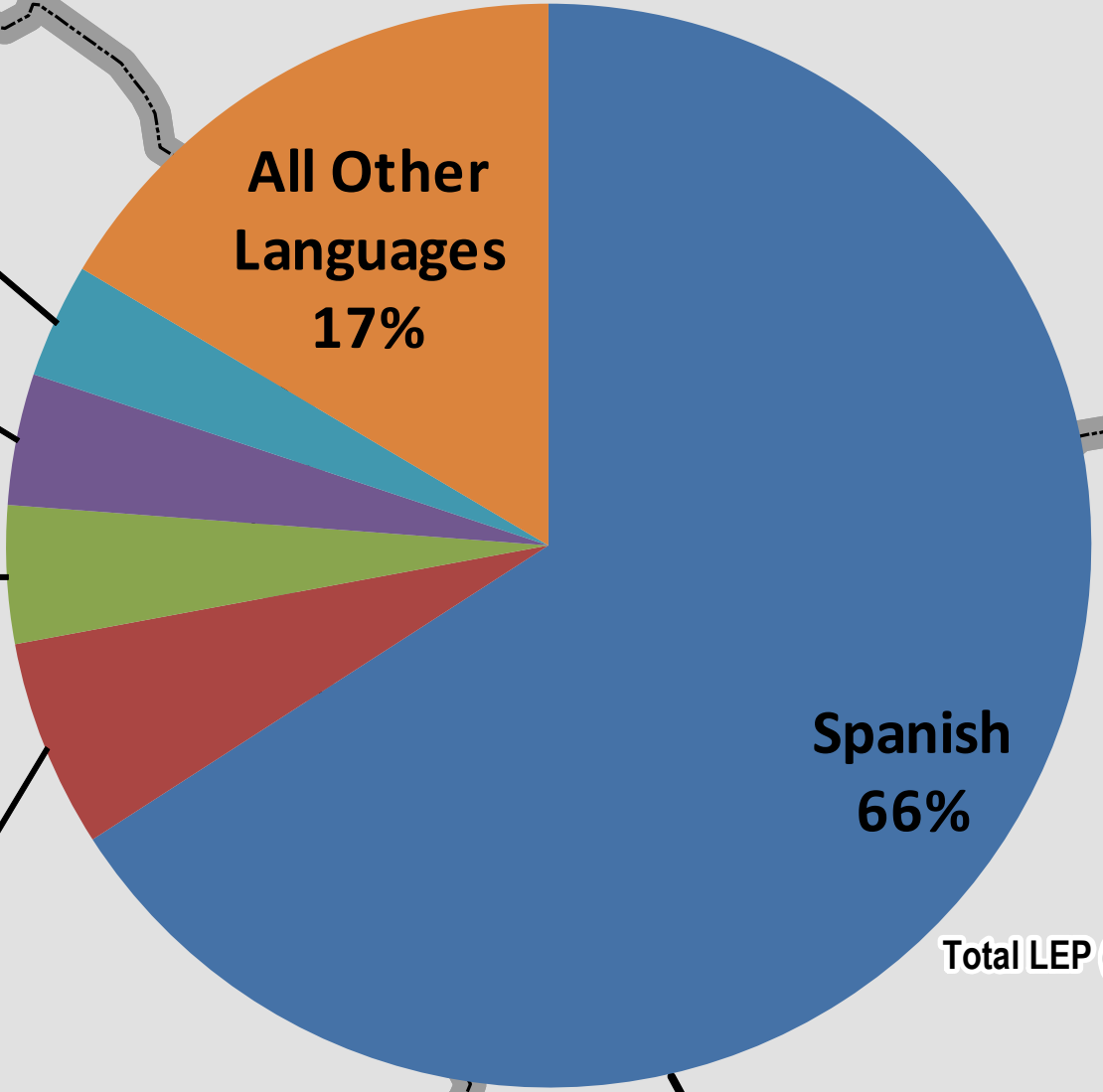
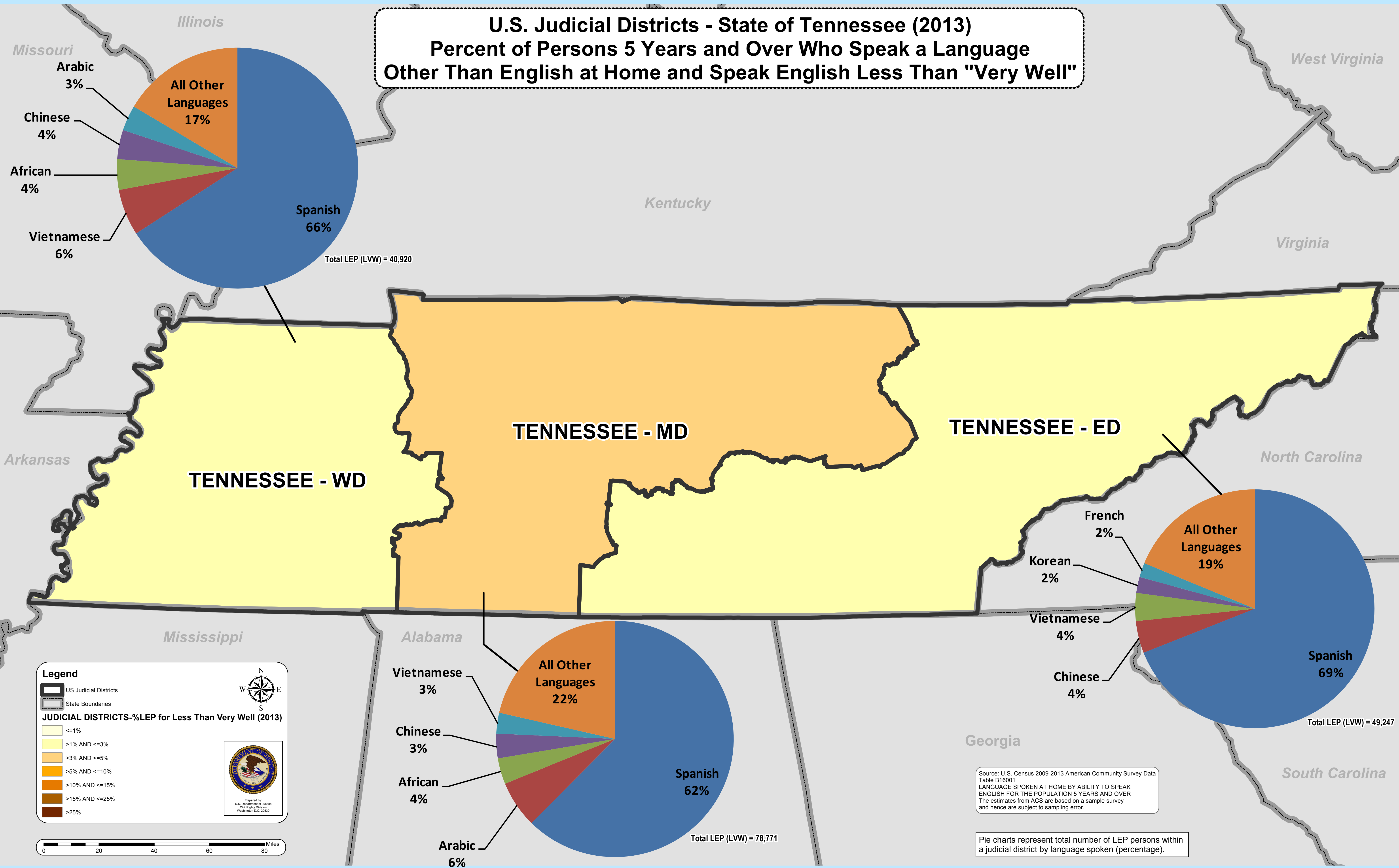
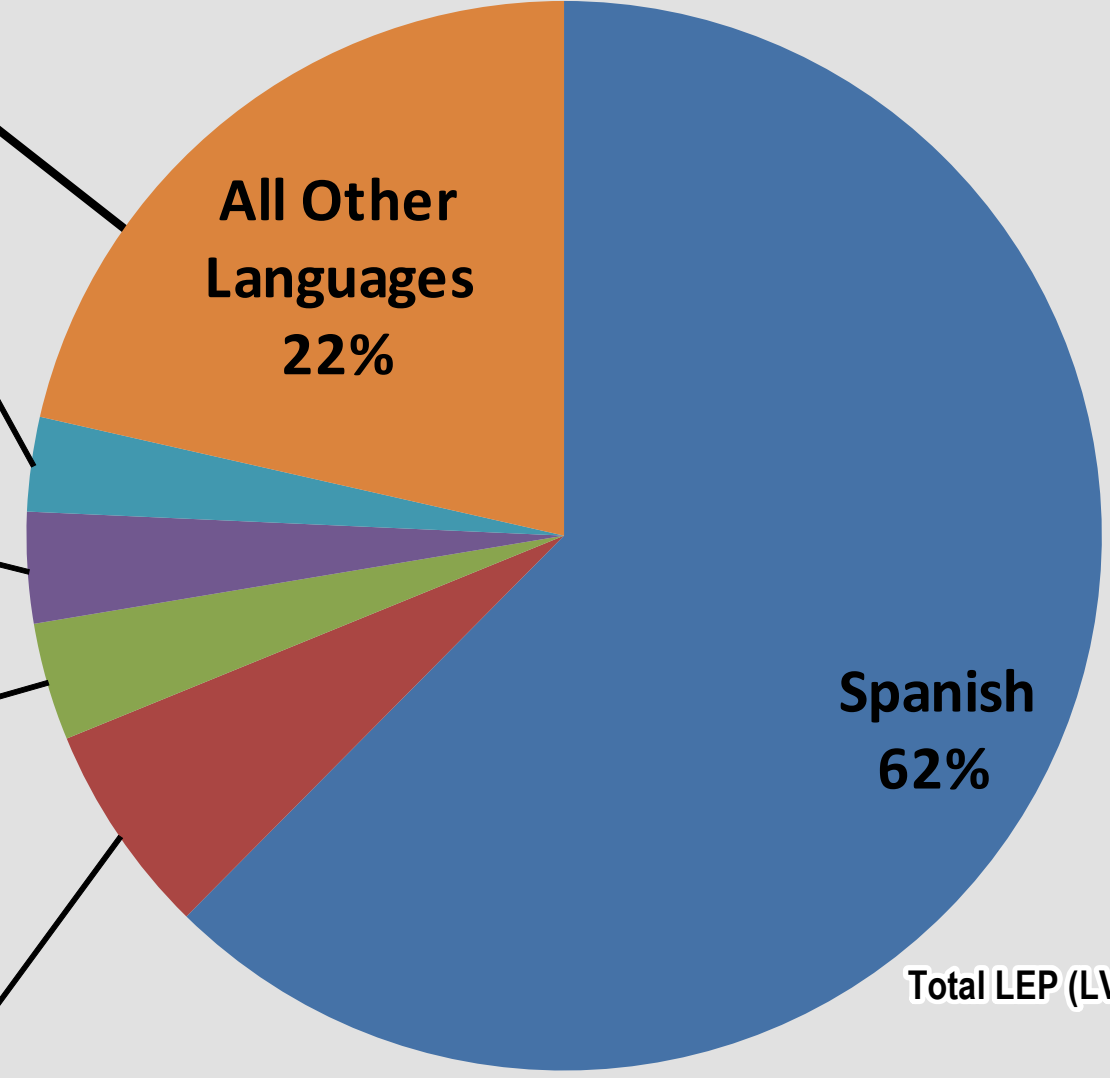
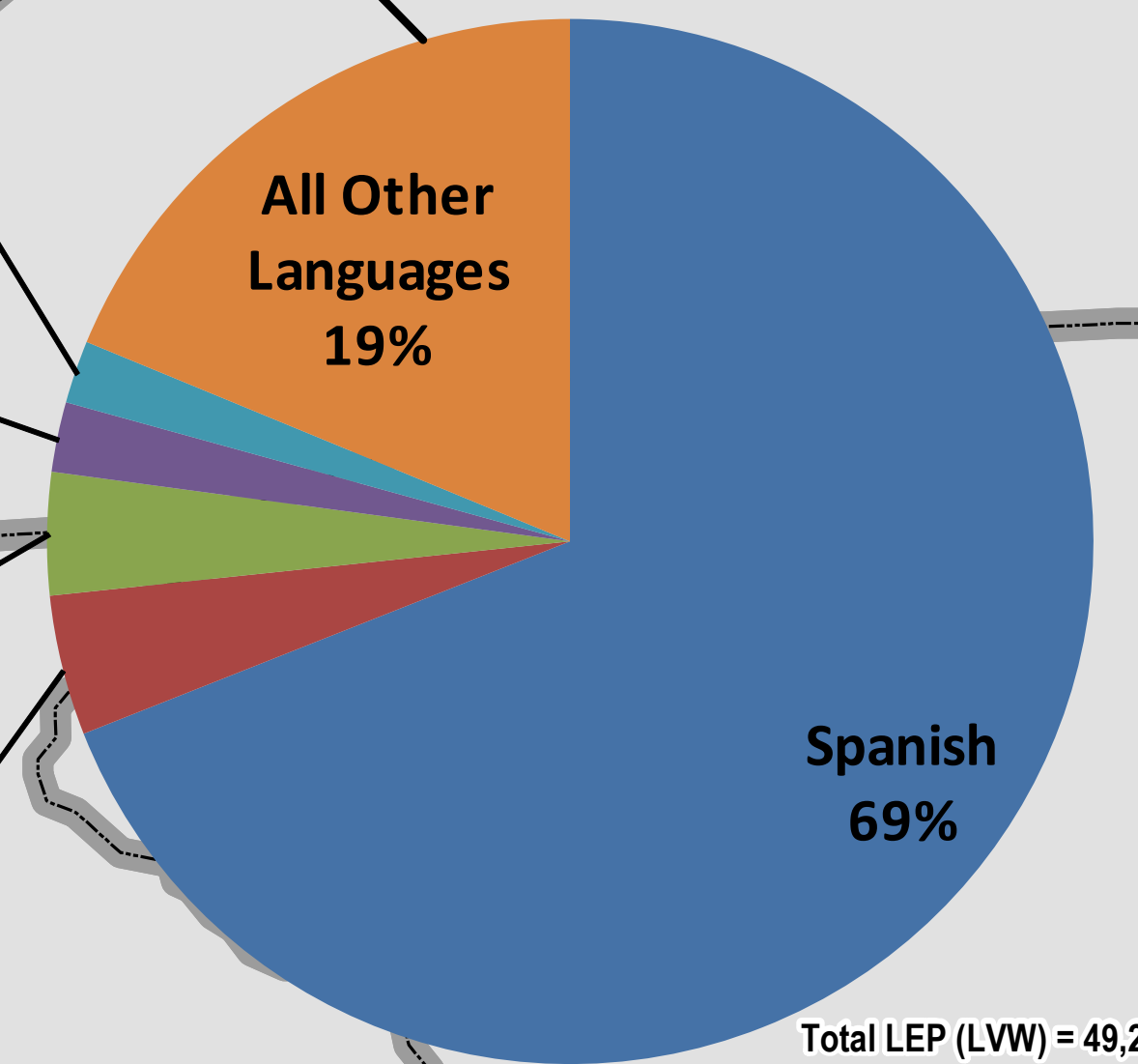


**U.S. Judicial Districts - State of Tennessee (2013)**

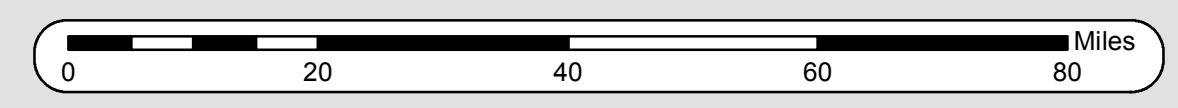
